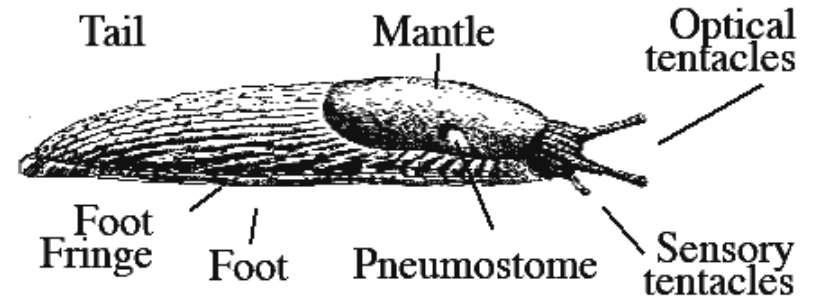

### Other Important Information

**Safety & Behavior:** *Safety is a priority during Slug Soup. Students are expected to abide by safety rules announced on the first day. This is a private event and have limited time to manage serious behavior issues. We expect **respectful, responsible students**. Parents, thanks for helping to reinforce this!*

**Attendance:** It's important that students plan to attend each day.  
**Who may attend:** Only registered students may attend classes. Students must be able to work independently of parents or grandparents (only background-checked *Slug Soup* personnel/volunteers are allowed in classrooms with students).

**Where to come:** Nestucca Jr/Sr High School located in Cloverdale, Oregon. In the center of town, turn up Bridge St. At the church, go left and follow Parkway Dr. up the hill to the school. Cloverdale is on Hwy 101, 22 mi. south of Tillamook, 18 mi. north of Lincoln City.

**What to bring:** Students staying for 2 classes a day should bring a sack lunch marked with child's name. Lunch-time will be supervised. All class materials are provided. Wear comfortable art clothes!

### For those entering K-1st grade

**Sounds Of Color In Summer** - Create and color unique wind chimes and sun catchers using mixed mediums and collected materials. *Instructor: Tami Walker, Cloverdale - Artist, Elementary Instructional Assistant.*

**A Camping We Will Go** - Create your own crafty camping gear and bring the outdoors in. *Instructor: Tami Walker, Cloverdale - Artist, Elementary Instructional Assistant.*

### For those entering 1st-2nd grade

**Shaped By The Masters** - Can you find the circles in Kandinsky's art, the rectangles of Mondrian's grids, the triangles of Thiebaud's pies? We will explore shapes and create our own shapely art using oil pastels, paint, markers, etc. We'll even create organic free-form shapes like Matisse. *Instructor: Renee Miller, Neotsu - Elementary Teacher, Art Literacy Instructor.*

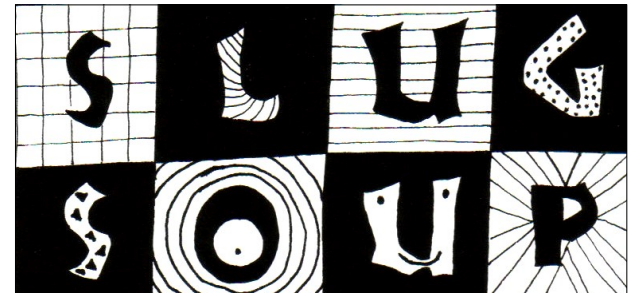
